

China Visa Application Requirements

1. Visa application form 'B' – Download from the site or Call our agent to get one. Fill in as much as possible.
2. Your actual Passport - Valid at least 6 months or more and at least one blank page with "Visas" at the top.
3. Photographs - One 2" x 2" color photo - affixed on the visa application form, it has to be standard. Some drugstore have this service for taking the passport photo.
4. Copy of your airline E-ticket receipt - If you don't have it yet by the time you are applying visa, please call our agent for help.
5. Copy of hotel reservations - covering your full length of stay if you apply for tourist visa. Call out agent for help.
6. An invitation letter - From your family/relative if you apply for tourist visa and stay at their home, along with a copy of your inviter's Chinese National ID or passport. Or call our agents for help.
7. Other documents - if deemed necessary by visa officers.
8. Type of Services (Processing Time) -
 - Regular service: 2-4 weeks after we receive the required application.
 - Express service: 1-2 weeks after we receive the required application.
9. Fee - Application Fee varies depending the type of the services and other additional services.
10. Type of Payment - Cash, Money order, Cashier's check payable to "Trans Global Travel".
11. Remark(Frequent Q & A):
 - If you were Born in China, or Born in Taiwan, or are Non-US Citizen, Chinese consulate requires more documents for the application, for more information, please call our office.
 - The two-year multiple entry visa is for US citizens who were born in China and their children. This visa is subject to approval of the consulate, who may grant a one-year multiple entry visa instead.
 - If you send application by mail to our office, we suggest you call our office to make sure

it's complete before you mail it.

- Please make sure all visa requirements are met. We will submit your documents to the Chinese consulate, but we are not authorized to validate your application. We cannot be held responsible for any delay or denial of your visa for any reason or for no reason from the consulate. All processing and delivery fees are non-refundable.
